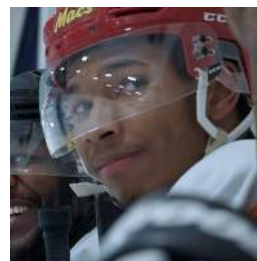
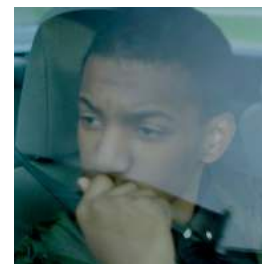

Her short film *Pick*, screening as part of this programme, won Best Live Action Short at the 2020 Canadian Screen Awards. Her 2021 short *Only Light Will Touch Us* won the Impact Award at the CineFam Film Festival.
