War			✓		Events from the Vietnam War are depicted: soldiers holding firearms, war sounds (gunshots, bombs, explosions) in the background, etc.
Weapons			✓		A young man hands a grenade to Sao Mãi; he gets shot in the head by a soldier (slightly graphic, some blood).
Unfit Conditions		✓			Refugees cramped in a boat under life-threatening conditions at sea, with very little fresh water; Thao mentions people being sick in the refugee camp and having barely any medicine.
Sexual Assault Reference	✓				Thao mentions briefly there were many pirate attacks, rapes and shipwrecks when refugees fled (not depicted on screen).
Death	✓				Sao Mãi talks about her mother's death in Vietnam.
